Pirate bottle opener.

- Stainless steel and matt black rubber.
- Corkscrew and Bottle Opener in one.
- Easy open lever effortlessly pulls corks.
- Serrated foil cutter to cleanly trim capsule.

The sommelier's favourite "Waiter's Friend" corkscrew. Pull corks like a professional. Integrated easy-open lever, foil-cutter and beer bottle opener. Designed like a peg-legged pirate with eye-patch, beard, hook hand, earring, black bandana and even a parrot. Forget Blackbeard, "Legless" is the hardest working pirate in the bar. A great kitchen gift.

Top Tip: On a waiter's friend, the hinged metal arm is designed to turn a hard pull into a controlled, efficient lift. The lever sits on the rim of the bottle neck and acts as a fulcrum. As you pull up on the handle, the lever pivots against the bottle, multiplying your force so the cork lifts out smoothly with less effort.
